

Top 10 IU Technology Tips for Students

- 1. Get a Box account:** Box at IU gives students 50 GB of storage and collaboration space in the cloud. Access it online, in the STCs, on the IUanyWare thin clients, from your mobile device and through software in IUanyWare! Use it for personal file storage or for collaboration in team projects. Just log in with your IU user ID and passphrase at box.iu.edu. Learn more at kb.iu.edu/data/bbox.html.
- 2. Authorize cloud storage:** Connect your Box account to the computers in the Student Technology Centers and Information Commons, IUanyWare thin clients and IUanyWare for your personal computer or mobile device via cloudStorage.iu.edu. Log in and choose Authorize Cloud Storage under the Box description.
- 3. Use IUanyWare:** Stream your favorite software like Microsoft Office or the Adobe Creative Suite to your desktop, laptop, smartphone or tablet via IUanyWare. Go to iuanyware.iu.edu from your computer OR visit <http://kb.iu.edu/data/bbbx.html> to configure your mobile device.
- 4. Download software from IUware:** hundreds of software titles are available to download while you are a student including Microsoft Office and the Adobe Creative Suite for Mac and for Windows! Visit IUware.iu.edu and choose download.
- 5. Increase your computing knowledge & skills:** Now that you have the software, learn how to make the most of it! Take IT Training classes online or in person, visit ittraining.iu.edu for the schedule. Can't wait? Learn via videos on demand with lynda.com. Visit lynda.iu.edu to get started.
- 6. Get IT Support when you need it:** UITS offers phone, live chat, e-mail and face-to-face IT support via the Support Center.
